

RETELL SEI Teacher Endorsement

Workshop Description: The *RETELL* (Rethinking Equity in the Teaching of English Language Learners) Program was designed to help teachers codify and address the performance gaps among our ELLs; the Teacher Endorsement course is one facet of RETELL. *Teachers who successfully complete this course will fulfill the requirements that all core academic teachers who have one or more ELLs in their classroom between SY2013 and SY2016 must earn the SEI endorsement.*



This course will focus on current effective practice and evidence-based research related to the teaching of ELLs in our schools. Effective teaching strategies will be modeled and participants will apply what they have seen and experienced in the course in their classroom teaching practice. Participants will also be able to evaluate their own practice and engage in supportive sharing with and feedback from colleagues. Teachers will enhance their teaching practice with new skills, knowledge and dispositions that focus on the successful learning of our ELLs. In one Capstone session, teachers will give a 10-15 minute presentation using skills and knowledge gained from the course.

About the Instructor: **Dr. Elise Frangos** currently serves as the Assistant Superintendent for the Old Rochester Regional Schools, where she oversees curriculum review and development, and instructional improvement, teacher leadership, mentoring, professional development as well as local and federal grants: Title 1, Title II and Title III. Elise works on areas of technologic improvement such as data privacy and integration of tech tools. Prior to coming to Old Rochester Regional Schools, she was a special education instructor in Hamilton-Wenham Regional Schools, an English teacher for many years and the Director of ELA and Reading for grades pre-K through 12 in Arlington. She is well versed in Massachusetts Common Core standards, having been a member of the Common Core Standards Review Committee that developed the Massachusetts Curriculum Framework. She taught English Language learners in Boston, Brookline and Arlington. She has taught the full SEI teacher and administrative endorsement courses on the South Coast and in Boston's Metro-west. Elise has served on several DESE committees as a curriculum model units writer and Framework reviewer. She recently revised the ELL compliance guidance with a WEST ED team. Elise is an approved SEI instructor for the state of Massachusetts.
