Course Description: Use this summer to follow a personal passion, a passion that might transfer to your classroom! Have you the desire to develop your passion to draw? Or to deepen your skills and interest in drawing? Participants will leave this course with increased confidence in their drawing skills! Participants can apply these skills to create more meaningful exemplars for students, to improve their visual problem solving skills, and to further differentiate instruction. By exploring drawing techniques like perspective, portraiture, and observational drawing, participants can not only learn but also continue to authentically encourage these abilities in their students.
