

DESE guidance for this year states that snow days and inclement weather days may be remote learning days. TEC will decide if snow days are remote learning days on a case-by-case basis, placing great consideration on the conditions for teaching and learning for both staff and students. Power outages, availability of educational materials and overall readiness of students and staff are factors that will be considered.

HOW WILL YOU KNOW IF TEC HAS CLOSED, A DELAYED OPENING OR A REMOTE LEARNING DAY?

A recorded phone message from **The Education Cooperative** will be sent to each family's primary phone contact through our telephone notification system, K-12 Alerts. You may want to add our number to your contacts: **781-352-5700**.

Additionally, for emergency weather closings, follow the school closing/delay announcements on the local news stations.

1. If all TEC programs in every community are closed, delayed, or remote, you will see a closing or delay notice from **The Education Cooperative**.
2. Under rare circumstances, the Executive Director may determine that inclement weather that threatens to make the afternoon commute unsafe requires an early dismissal from school. If such a decision is made, TEC will notify families using our telephone notification system, K-12 Alerts

Transportation:

We encourage families to contact their child's Van Driver to be sure they are aware of any delays or closings. Please note that if your local community cancels or delays school, van transportation to TEC might not be available to transport your child or may operate on the sending district's delayed schedule.
