Synchronous, LiveLesson, Opportunities:

Elementary Primary Grades (K-2)

Core content sessions

Our K-2 learners have the opportunity to attend the following core content LiveLesson sessions weekly:

- Math, one session per week
- Science, one session per week
- Social Studies, one session per week
- Literacy/Language Arts, one session daily

Culture building and social-emotional learning sessions

Students also have a number of opportunities to meet with their teacher each week. Those opportunities include:

- Homeroom Huddle, one session per week (every Monday)
- D.I.S.H. (Drop In Say Hi), one session per week (every Friday)
- Teacher Time, teachers have set aside two hours each week when students can drop in the LiveLesson classroom and work individually with their teacher
- Students also have the ability to book an appointment to meet individually with a teacher at a day/time that works best for their schedule

Elective course sessions

Elective course offerings vary by course. Most elementary elective courses offer one LiveLesson session, every other week. A small number of elective courses offer one LiveLesson session per month.

Intervention sessions

As part of our Response to Intervention process, teachers identify students who may be struggling with specific concepts and develop short (15-20 minute) targeted intervention sessions to support student mastery. Teachers will invite students who need support on a specific standard or objective to join a live instructional session.

Elementary Upper Grades (3-5)

Core content sessions

Our 3-5 learners have the opportunity to attend the following core content LiveLesson sessions weekly:

- Math, one session per week
- Science, one session per week
- Social Studies, one session per week
- Language Arts, one session per week

Culture building and social-emotional learning sessions

Students also have a number of opportunities to meet with their teacher each week. Those opportunities include:

Teachers will invite students who need support on a specific standard or objective to join a live instructional session.
